REACH 1907/2006/EC Regulation

Registration, Evaluation, Authorisation & restriction of Chemicals (REACh) Declaration

REACH is a regulation of the European Union, adopted to improve the protection of human health and the environment from the risks that can be posed by chemicals, while enhancing the competitiveness of the EU chemicals industry.

REACH defines an article as an object which during production is given a special shape, surface or design that determines its function to a greater degree than its chemical composition. The candidate list of substances now effect clothing, flooring, furniture, jewellery, fastenings, plastic, rubber, plasticisers, coating products, flame retardants, paints, pulp, paper, packaging, adhesives, inks, toners, washing and cleaning products.

Manufacturers, importers, or anyone who places products in the EU market must comply which REACH Annex XVII requirements, including ensuring that the concentration level of regulated substances is kept under the prescribed limit. Thus, products that contain restricted substances above the set limitations, can't be placed (as in sold) in the EU market.

PFAS are a group of chemical substances that are often added to plastics to improve the flexibility and durability of the products. Currently, REACH Annex XVII restricts the use of some phthalates to a maximum of 0.1% by weight in plasticized materials, including: DEHP, DBP, BBP and DIBP. REACH was last updated on the 23^{rd of} January 2024 with an additional five substances.

Companies are responsible for managing the risks of these chemicals and must also give their customers and consumers information to use them safely.

We hereby confirm that products supplied by Tasman Industries Ltd comply with REACh Regulations 235 SVHC, and that we will inform you of any substances presence above the threshold allowed.
